Renovations Update from Bob Nelson

In April the health department questioned the adequacy of our septic system to handle 300 people in one day, which would occur with two services at the maximum occupancy of 150 people. Larry Simpson performed a series of tests in May which verified the system capacity far exceeded the design requirement.

As a result, Pete Bussett provided the EIR consultant with suggested wording and mitigation provisions which have been incorporated and the consultant has submitted the revised EIR. The only open task for our resubmittal of the CUP application is further analysis of the storm water containment which Pete expects the civil engineer, Sean Savage, will complete this week and the revised CUP will be submitted next week.

Pete believes we have adequately addressed all the other issues the city brought forth in their April communication. We can expect any further issues that the city wants to bring forth within the next thirty days. An EIR hearing will be held after that and we should be able to start preparation of construction drawings after EIR approval.
