Chalice will participate in a project with Escondido Together, Mosques Against Trafficking, and First Congregational Church of Escondido to provide backpack to survivors of human trafficking. Police and social service organizations will distribute the backpacks to the people they encounter.

The backpacks will contain clothing items, personal care items, snacks, etc. Chalice has been asked to provide 100 notepads (about 5" by 7") and 100 pencils (or pens).

The backpacks will be assembled at First Congregational (1800 N Broadway) on Saturday, September 22 from 10:00 to Noon. Everyone is welcome to help stuff the backpack with these items.
