What to do if an armed intruder comes to Chalice

On Sunday, February 16, 2020 at 12:30pm in the Chapel, our security consultant, Mr. Allen Owens, will provide a training session on how to respond should an armed intruder or disruptive person enter the Chapel during a Sunday service.

Mr. Owens is a retired Escondido police officer and during two visits to our campus has assured us that we are in a low risk area. Nonetheless, the Chalice Safety and Security Team feels that we need to understand what to do in the event the unthinkable should happen at Chalice.

All congregants are invited to attend this session to be aware of our ongoing security efforts.
