What were your goals for this year? What are your accomplishments?

Our plans for this year were to install film on the windows of the Hub, Chapel and Fellowship building and to install a camera security system. These goals were dependent on receiving a grant from the Chalice Lighters. Since we are not currently meeting at Chalice and the grant was not approved until this month (June 2021), these plans have not been realized.

What we were able to do was participate with a team of Chalice folks to check on the Chalice campus every day. Marshall, Richard and I each went by the campus once a week nearly every week of the past year.

How was your group impacted by the pandemic and quarantine?

The pandemic held up the awarding of the Chalice Lighters grant, so we were not able to install the window film or camera system.

When and how often were and are the meetings?

During the past year, we have met quarterly by Zoom: July 28, 2020; November 13, 2020; February 19, 2021 and June 18, 2021

How are new people welcomed to join?

We have not actively recruited new members so far. Should someone express interest in joining, they would be invited to our meetings and asked for their input in any discussions and decisions we make.
